Independence Day: Independence Day commemorates the signing of the Declaration of Independence by the Continental Congress on July 4, 1776 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Philadelphians marked the first anniversary of American Independence with a spontaneous celebration. However, observing Independence Day only became commonplace after the War of 1812. Finally, Congress passed a law on June 28, 1870 making it a federal holiday and then declared it a national holiday in 1941.

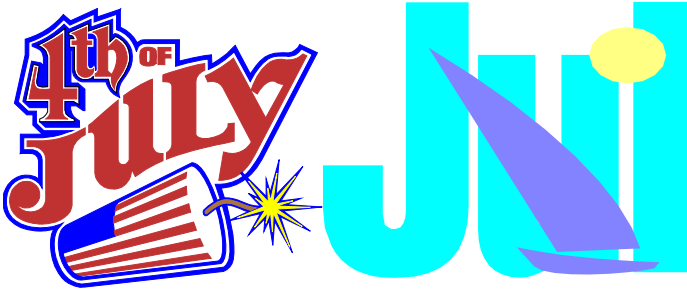
